Joe Fincham is the Head Coach at Wittenberg University. Coach Fincham's tenure as Wittenberg's head football coach can be characterized as nothing short of a tremendous success. He has led his team to North Coast Athletic Conference titles in 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2006 and six NCAA Division III playoff berths. Fincham has also earned several coaching honors as he was selected NCAC Coach of the Year in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2006, and American Football Coaches Association/Kodak District IV Coach of the Year in 1998. Through the 2008 season, Fincham has led the Tigers to stunning an overall record of 114 – 29.
