Tradition of Wittenberg Basketball

Wittenberg University is the all-time winningest NCAA Division III program in the country by both total victories and winning percentage. Taking all NCAA programs into account, the Tigers have the third best winning percentage which places them in front of such programs as Duke, Kansas, and UCLA. Dating back to the 1956-57 season, Wittenberg has had fifty consecutive winning seasons.

Camp Director – Instructional Staff

Bill Brown is in his thirty-first year of college basketball coaching. During his thirteen years as the head coach at Wittenberg, Brown's teams have compiled a record of 327-75. Brown has more than thirty years of summer basketball camp experience. This experience and his daily presence and involvement with campers make Brown one of the leading camp directors in the Midwest. The camp instructional staff will include some of the best available high school and college coaches in the state. In addition, the staff will include current Tiger players and coaches.

Outstanding Facilities

All camp activities are conducted in the Health, Physical Education, and Recreation (HPER) Center on the Wittenberg University campus. The HPER Center includes 5 full courts and 22 basket areas. Three courts are in an **air-conditioned** gym. Campers will also have access to the Olympic size swimming pool.

Firestone Hall, the residence hall used for camp is also **air-conditioned**. It is located approximately 100 yards from the HPER Center. Camp coaches reside in the same dormitory as campers and provide meal break and evening supervision. Roommate assignments are made according to registration form requests. Others will be paired with campers of comparable age range. The **air-conditioned** campus dining hall, located in the university student center, is approximately 150 yards from Firestone Hall.

Camp Fee

The camp fee structure is as follows:

- Resident camper – \$295 (includes all basketball sessions, all meals, residence hall stay, camper t-shirt)
- *Extended day camper – \$210 (includes all basketball sessions, all meals except breakfasts, camper t-shirt)
- *Day camper – \$160 (includes both Sunday sessions/Sunday dinner, other day morning/afternoon sessions/lunches)
