Outstanding Facilities

All games are played in the **air-conditioned** Health, Physical Education, and Recreation (HPER) Center on the Wittenberg University campus. The HPER Center includes 5 full courts and 20 basket areas. Players also have access to the Olympic size swimming pool.

Firestine Hall, the residence hall used for camp is also **air-conditioned**. It is located approximately 100 yards from the HPER Center. Each school's coaches will stay in the same dormitory area as their teams. The campus dining hall is **air-conditioned** and is located approximately 100 yards from Firestine Hall.

Team Camp Schedule

Each team plays a total of ten games. Games consist of two-16 minute halves using running time until the last minute of both halves. Although five (5) game courts are available, each division will have only ten (10) teams. Teams in one division alternate game times with the other division. NO team sits out more than one game period (45 minutes). This camp setup provides for the absolute minimal time possible to be out of game action.

Camp Fee

The camp fee schedule per player is shown below. Checks or money orders should be made payable to Wittenberg Basketball Camps. Player's camp fees and medical insurance forms will be collected by the team's coach and forwarded to Wittenberg at one time.

Coaches Package

One coach per each of the 20 teams receives a \$200 coaching stipend, room and meals, and evening food and refreshments. Coaches do no officiating or scoring. **THERE IS A NECESSARY CHARGE FOR EXTRA COACHES.**

Remember, we only register ten teams for each of the two different playing divisions of all three team camps. **A non-refundable \$150 camp deposit per team is due by May 15.** This \$150 deposit will either be credited to overall player fees of that school or be refunded to the coach upon arrival at camp. **Individual player information and medical insurance forms will be forwarded to coaches for distribution to players.**

One-Day Varsity Shootouts – June 20 and July 18

These one-day events, for **varsity teams only**, include sixteen teams playing either four or five games. Games consist of two-20 minute running time halves with the clock being stopped the last minute of both halves. Team fee is \$185. **An officiating camp is again on schedule to run in conjunction with both shootout events.** Register at the phone number and/or email address given above.

Tradition of Wittenberg Basketball

Wittenberg University is the all-time winningest NCAA Division III program in the country by both total victories and winning percentage. Taking all NCAA programs into account, the Tigers have the third best winning percentage which places them in front of such programs as Duke, Kansas, and UCLA. Wittenberg has had fifty consecutive winning seasons. Tiger teams have an overall record of 305-70 during Bill Brown's twelve years as the head coach.
