Comments:

Wittenberg, ranked ninth in the Great Lakes Region, battled Wilmington, ranked fifth in the Great Lakes Region and 19th in the country, to a 3-3 tie after 90 minutes of regulation and two-15-minute sudden-death overtime periods.

Wittenberg started out strong, scoring a goal in the fifth minute when freshman midfielder Jessica Wright scored off an assist from freshman midfielder Rene D'Aloiso. After Wilmington took the lead with a pair of first-half goals, the Tigers tied the game in the 61st minute as D'Aloiso scored and then took the lead when sophomore midfielder Jill Rekers ripped a shot from 25 yards out.

Wilmington tied the score with just 1:26 to play in the match. The two teams then played two overtime periods but neither could break through for the game-winner.

Wittenberg sophomore goalkeeper Jenny Miller made 16 saves in goal for the Tigers.
